Online mentoring and support workshops for the development of your water charter as well as providing peer to peer learning opportunities

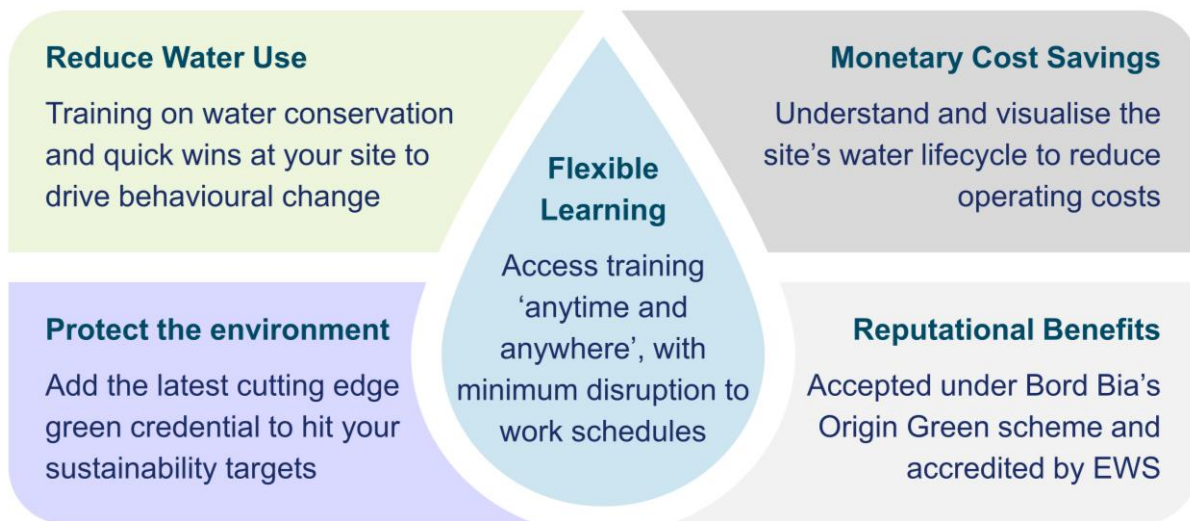
