Dear Mr. Ryan,

I write in connection with the Historic Towns Grants Scheme 2022 and Kildare County Councils application for the revitalisation of Naas's Historic Potato Market. I wish to support this application for Naas.

This funding will be essential in resurrecting an area and building of historical importance to Naas and the wider region. Should this application be successful, it will enable Kildare County Council to develop this site into a modern town centre market, and the possibilities for the space to be used for outdoor entertainment and other civic and cultural initiatives.
